Our son is now in Secondary II and looking back we can say it was the best decision we could have made. The Royal West community was welcoming and supportive. He was provided with an IEP that ensures teachers are able to make allowances for his mal formed right hand in courses including Physical Education, Science & Technology and Music and anywhere else that his impediment must be taken into consideration. Guidance Services were there to answer our questions and resources were available to guide us through the IEP process. He has chosen to pursue Music as his arts option, in part due to the wonderful support of his teacher and while he will probably always be “you know, Ben with the small hand” he has become a happy and thriving member of the Royal West family.”
