Students are free to read as many books as they wish from the summer reading list, but are **required to read two (2)**. No other titles may be substituted. Summer reading assessment will cover the first few weeks of September and includes evaluation for both the reading competency and the production competency.

Students will be expected to: Analyze quotes from the novels, work collaboratively with others on a summer reading project, and share their ideas about the novels in small groups. Formal instructions for these assignments will be provided at the start of the school year.

IMPORTANT information: All students will be required to complete the *RWA Summer Reading Reflection* document. This document will be made available to all students on the RWA website and is a standard document for all grade levels. The purpose of the reflection is to think critically about the novel and be creative. Detailed instructions are on the document itself. The document will not be collected on the first day back, but expect to submit it sometime during the first cycle.

Please note that some of these books have mature themes; we encourage students to consult reviews and/or speak to their teacher to make sure the books they choose to read are a good fit.
