You may read as many books from the list as you wish, but you *must* read **two** (2). There is no anchor novel, so you may choose whichever two you are most interested in. You are expected to read the books carefully to prepare for summer reading projects which will take place over the course of September.

Students in grade 8 will be **required to complete** the **2021 RWA Summer Reading Reflection document**. This document will be made available to students on the RWA website. The purpose of the reflection is to think critically about the novel and be creative. Detailed instructions are on the document itself. The document will not be collected on the first day back, but expect to submit it sometime during the first cycle.

As you will be completing projects on the books in the fall, you are encouraged to take some notes while reading. Highlighting or marking off key passages is a good idea, as is jotting down some notes while reading to help you keep track of characters, setting, plot, conflict, etc. This is not mandatory, but highly encouraged because it will help you with the projects in the fall.

Please note that some of these books have mature themes; we encourage students to consult reviews to make sure the books they choose to read are a good fit. Have a great summer and happy reading!
