BOYS FLAG FOOTBALL **NEW!**

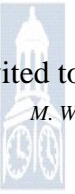
Practice on Tuesday September 21st at 3:10 pm. Meet near the new gym ready to go outside. Bring your cleats.

All COVID vaccinations at RWA will take place in the morning.

Walk-ins: Please note that walk-in appointments will be available. You will need to bring your medicare card - students under the age of 14 (12-13 year-olds) will need to present themselves with parental consent form signed (see the office to get a copy).

Pre-scheduled appointments: You will need to bring your medicare card - students under the age of 14 (12-13 year-olds) will need to present themselves with parental consent form signed. Vaccinations will occur in the morning, regardless of the chosen appointment time.
