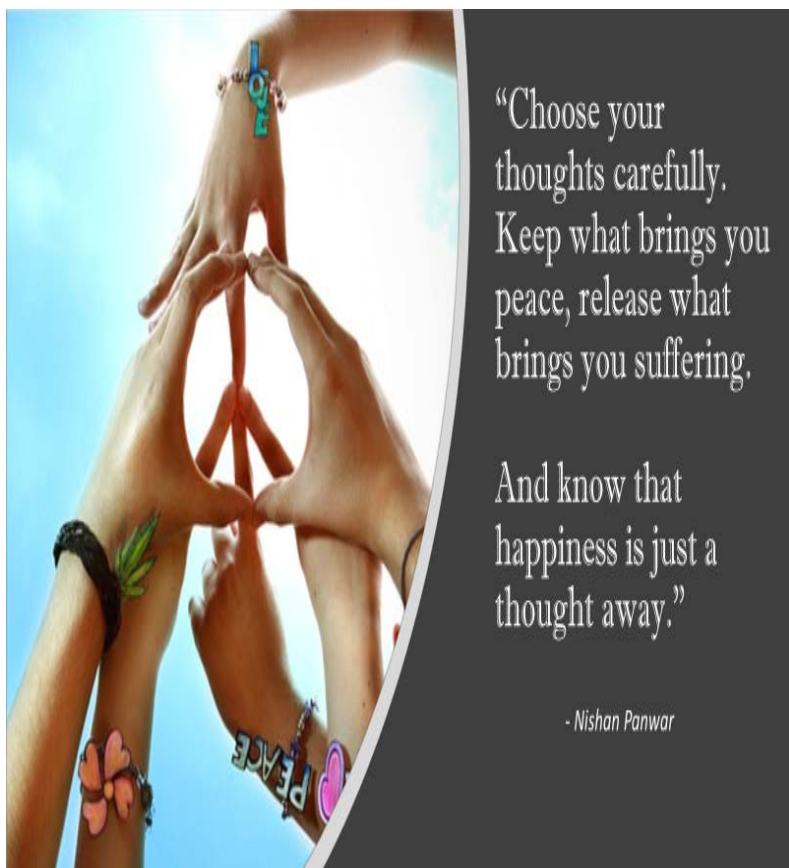

Indigenous communities still face multiple problems, many of which are rooted in the residential school experience.

As an act of reconciliation and hope for the future, you may **show your support by wearing an orange shirt (or an orange piece of fabric pinned to your shirt)** to school on Thursday, September 30, 2021. Students of RWA may make a **voluntary donation** in homeroom.

All donations will go to **the Native Friendship Centre of Montreal**. This organization helps Indigenous communities by providing education, as well as health and social services. They also have a program to help former Residential school students and their families.
