This Olympic-style sporting event for Jewish teens ages 13-16 is held every summer. More than 2,000 athletes from delegations across North America, Europe, Latin America, Israel, and beyond, attend the competition. Hosted by communities around the country, they compete in team or individual sports and participate in social activities and social action projects rooted in Jewish values. The JCC Maccabi Games® are hosted by JCC Association of North America in partnership with Maccabi World Union, Maccabi Canada, and Maccabi USA/Sports for Israel. Kitchen Clean-up will continue this Thursday. Please come to room 104 Thursday at lunch from 12:26 - 12:56. You will have time to eat afterwards.

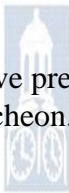
