The Foundation launched the Active Learning Classroom campaign November 2022.

Recap: The [Active Learning Classroom](#) encourages individualized learning, collaboration between students and teachers, and has been shown to increase engagement and motivation among students. Three classrooms have been identified for a Pilot Project. These are Rooms 313 (Math and Science), 301 (History and Ethics), and 209 (English and Drama). The Foundation has an objective to raise a minimum of \$80,000 for the pilot project. This is a multi-year project and based on the results, the objectives will then be set for the following year.
