<u>Recap:</u> The Foundation launched the Active Learning Classroom campaign November 2022. The <u>Active Learning Classroom</u> encourages individualized learning, collaboration between students and teachers, and has been shown to increase engagement and motivation among students. Three classrooms have been identified for a Pilot Project. These are Rooms 313 (Math and Science), 301 (History and Ethics), and 209 (English and Drama). The Foundation has an objective to raise a minimum of \$80,000 for the pilot project. This is a multi-year project and based on the results, the objectives will then be set for the following year.

Activities: January 2023

- Prepared package for solicitation of Private Foundations
- Prepared and sent tax receipts for 2022
- Established design for room 313

Planned Activities: February-March 2023

- Start solicitation of Private Foundations (post signoff from GB on letter)
- Prepare for presence at in-school events in March
- Preparation of Spring Communication to RWA Parents and Donors
- Finalize donor plaque for PAC
- Validate idea Foundation Event (spring or fall TBD)
- Through RWA newsletter, parent, and donor communications, educate parents on the benefits of Active Learning Classrooms through testimonials
