



## **RWA Foundation Report**

April 27, 2023

Recap: The Foundation launched the Active Learning Classroom campaign November 2022. The Active Learning Classroom encourages individualized learning, collaboration between students and teachers, and has been shown to increase engagement and motivation among students. Three classrooms have been identified for a Pilot Project. These are Rooms 313 (Math and Science), 301 (History and Ethics), and 209 (English and Drama). The Foundation has an objective to raise a minimum of \$80,000 for the pilot project. This is a multi-year project and based on the results, the objectives will then be set for the following year.

## **Activities: March 2023**

- RWAF presence at in-school event (at Wager) March 24
- Prepared and sent 8 grant requests to Private Foundations (12 cumulative). We are currently following up with these organizations.
- Prepared and sent to RWA admin the Spring Communication to RWA Parents and Donors
- Developed ideas for partnership with small-medium sized businesses in the community.
  These will be implemented to support the Fall 2023 Campaign launch event (Fall date TBC).

## Planned Activities: April 2023

- Set calendar of RWA Foundation meetings for 2023-2024 school year (done)
- Continue soliciting Private Foundations
- Finalize design and order donor plaque for PAC
- Through RWA newsletter, parent, and donor communications, continue to educate parents on the benefits of Active Learning Classrooms through testimonials
- Develop slideshow to run continuously on the TV in school's atrium
