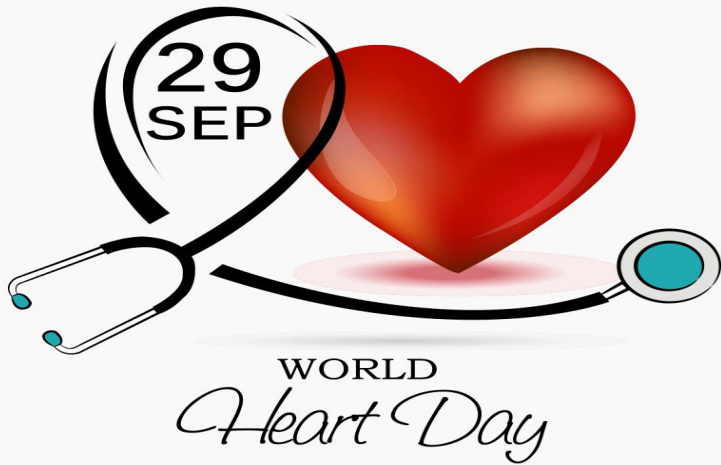


Royal West Academy

Nik Witkowski, RWA class of 1993 is the only RWA grad to participate in the Men's Rugby World Cup. Nik played professionally in France, Wales and England, and was selected to play for Canada 34 times. He played for the national team at the 2003 RWC, starting in all three of Canada's pool games.

Two other RWA grads have represented Canada in rugby. Caleb Jordan, class of 2009 spent a season playing for the National Men's 7-a-side team in the world 7's circuit. Thomas Artmann-Sherren, class of 2017 represented Canada at the U18 and U20 levels.
