Black Canadian Trailblazers and Changemakers - Did you know?

Dr. Dorothy Williams is a Montreal based historian, educator, researcher, author, content developer and consultant. Dr. Williams specializes in Black Canadian history and is a go to resource for many films and publications on the subject. In more recent years, Dr Williams created The ABC's of Canadian Black History, a resource kit to help both teachers and students learn more about the contributions of Black Canadians. Last year, the Afromuseum of Montreal featured an inaugural exhibit on Dr. Williams entitled 'Dr. Dorothy Williams: Changemaker'.

This was the first in a series of exhibitions allowing the public to discover Montreal's Black communities' history through the experiences and journeys of their guiding personalities.


