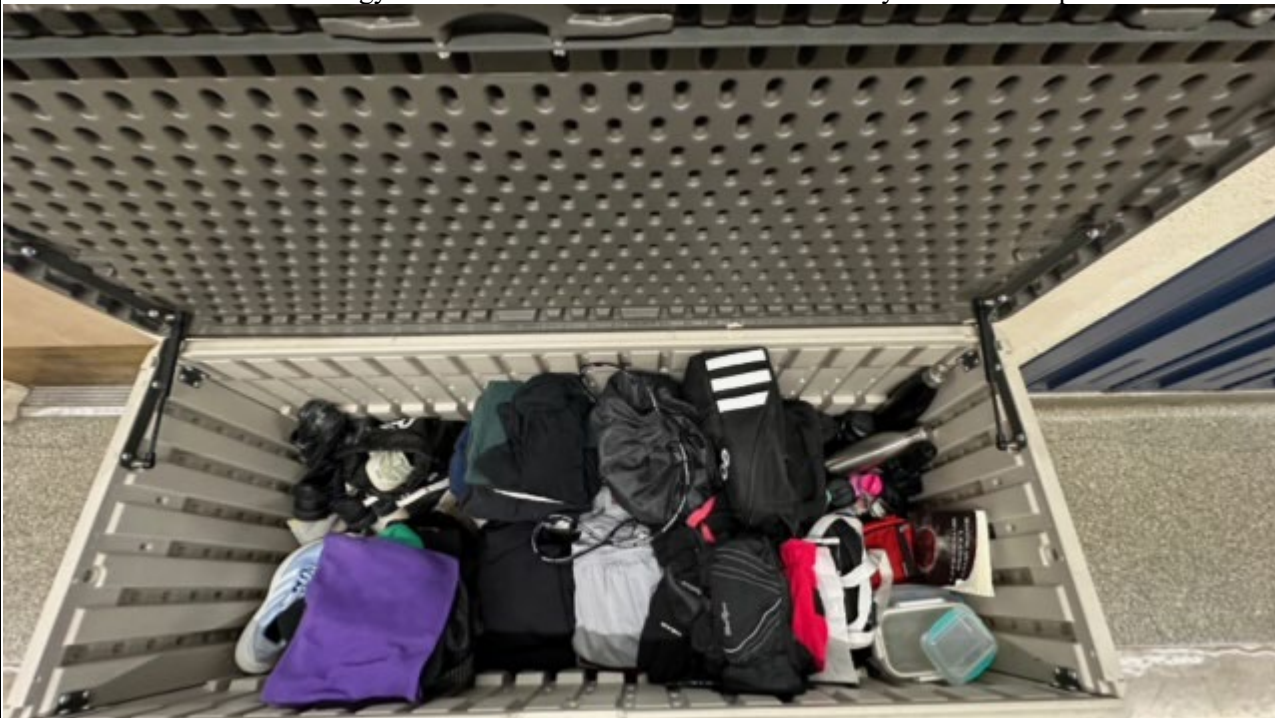

"2024 Diversity in Research Experiences Across Mathematics (DREAMs) Institute", hosted by the Pacific Institute for the Mathematical Sciences (PIMS).

The *PIMS Diversity in Research Experiences Across Mathematics (DREAMs) Institute* is a three-week online summer enrichment program designed to provide high school students in their last year or two of studies an opportunity to explore the pursuit of mathematics at the University level. Participants will be introduced to four foundational areas of mathematics by guest lecturers during the first week and then work on inquiry based projects with the support of the lecturers and graduate teaching assistants.

No application essay or application fee is required. Students can simply go into the website above to fill out the online form, which will take only 5 minutes. Alternatively, high school teachers or mentors can nominate students who they feel will benefit from the camp experience.
